

COVID-19 PROTECTION FRAMEWORK ORANGE SETTING

INFORMATION FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS AND VISITORS



30 December 2021

The Auckland Region is changing from its current **Red Setting** under the **COVID-19 Protection Framework** to the **Orange Setting** from **11.59pm on Thursday 30th of December 2021**. Please also see the Trust Board Draft **Policies for Residents and Visitors with or without a My Vaccine Pass in regards to accessing and using our Village Community Facilities**.

Life at Orange

- Wear a face covering on flights, public transport, taxis, shops and public venues (mandatory)
- You can visit public places like libraries and shops (with limits based on the size of venue)
- Go to workplaces
- Go to education places (with health measures in place).

My Vaccine Pass allows you to go to the following with no limits:

- Cafes, restaurants and bars
- Gatherings like weddings and funerals, and gatherings at home
- Close-proximity businesses like your hairdresser
- The gym or other member-based businesses like dance or martial art studios.

Without My Vaccine Pass there are restrictions that apply:

- Only allowed contactless pickups at cafes, restaurants and bars
- Small gatherings can be up to 50 people, based on the size of the venue.
If held at home, maximum 50 regardless of the size of the house
- Cannot attend indoor or outdoor events
- Outdoor community gatherings with uncontrolled access have a maximum of 50 people
- Cannot go to the gym or other member-based businesses like dance or martial art studios
- Cannot visit close-proximity businesses like hair dressers.

Do Family or Friends from the Village have access to Residents in the Care Centre?

Only general family member visits will be allowed. No general friend visits unless this has been approved on exceptional grounds by the Clinical Manager. General visiting hours to Residents are restricted from 9.30am to 4.30pm, 7 days a week.

You will still need to book through Reception an appointment for a maximum of 30 minutes per day in the Resident's room or in the Atrium, wearing a mask at all times and keeping 1-metre distance. When you come to visit you will need to show Reception your *My Vaccine Pass* or provide evidence of a *negative COVID-19 PCR Test* completed within 48 - 72 hours prior to your visit.

Village Residents using the Atrium

If you are a Resident within the Village using the Atrium you must wear a mask at all times, have a *My Vaccine Pass* or provide evidence of a *negative COVID-19 PCR Test* completed within 48 - 72 hours prior to your visit and maintain a 2-metre distance from Care Centre Residents.
