Hi all,

COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Update

Since my May report unfortunately there has been a concerning increase in the number of reported cases (may be influenced by the colder winter type weather) from early May when there was only 2,343 to 6,636 on 29 May 2024. Once again the continuing pattern is that only a third of these are actual new cases with two thirds being reinfections. Also as noted in my previous reports it is important to note that that while there has been an increase in reported cases, this figure is still well below the peak of cases in June 2022 (nearly 30,000 in a week).

Given this increase in Covid numbers I would encourage you to get new Booster Vaccine on Wednesday, 5th June 2024 at 10.30am in the Atrium, if you have not already had it. A separate reminder notice and consent form has already been sent out to all village residents, and it is not too late to bring your signed forms to reception. This new Booster targets the latest COVID 19 Omicron variant XBB15.

Repairs or part replacement of lower Roofs on some Villas

Over the last few months some residents may have noticed iron roof repairs or part replacements have been done on some Villa's due to some identified leaks. With the wetter Winter months ahead, if there are any leaks in your roof please log the job on the Skillet system or call Russelle on Reception to log the job. We will then arrange for Sumich Plumbing and Drainage to inspect your roof to see if a simple repair can be done or if part/all of the iron roof area may need replacing (at no expense to residents).

Sale of Villas.

The buyer of Villa 56 settled and moved into their refurbished Villa from Friday 24th May. Thus I am pleased to report all 91 Villa's at Ons Dorp are now occupied at the time of writing this Report. This has had a positive impact on the Village finances.

Cleaning and Painting of Soffits in Villas

Bryce Carters team are continuing water blasting the Soffits (the skirting boards underneath the Villa roof) to enable them to be re-painted white. They have already done approx. over 80% of the 91 Villas in the Village.

RECYCLING TOP TIPS

Keep it clean - empty and rinse ALL containers

Remove ALL lids and put them in the rubbish bin

DO NOT crush or flatten containers, no containers larger than 4L.

DO NOT place newspapers, cardboard etc in plastic bags, better to place in a cardboard box.

ONLY cardboard packing boxes should be flattened. If in doubt, leave it out

These can go in your recycling bin

Clean plastic containers, bottles and trays numbers 1, 2, 5 only (lids off, max size 4 litres)

Clean tins and cans

Clean, flat paper and cardboard

Clean unbroken glass jars and bottles – NO LIDS
