COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Update

As stated in my June Report there has been a concerning increase in the number of reported cases (may be influenced by the colder winter type weather) from early May when there was only 2,343 to 8,943 on 23rd June 2024. Once again the continuing pattern is that just under a third of these are actual new cases with approximately two thirds being reinfections. Also as noted in my previous reports it is important to note that while there has been an increase in reported cases, this figure is still well below the peak of cases in June 2022 (nearly 30,000 in a week).

Given this increase in Covid numbers if you did not get the latest Vaccine Booster shot on the 5th June at the Village I would encourage you to go your local Chemist and the latest Booster shot. It is important to note that this new Booster targets the latest COVID 19 Omicron variant XBB15.

Repairs or part replacement of lower Roofs

Over the last few months we are continuing to monitor Villa iron roofs and as required repairs or undertaking part replacements to stop any identified leaks. During the wetter winter months if there are any leaks in your roof please log the job on Skillet or call Russelle on Reception to log the job for you. Arrangements will then be made for Laser Plumbing Te Atatu (previously Sumich Plumbing and Drainage) to inspect your roof. If any repairs are needed this is at no expense to residents.

We now have one Villa that is coming up for sale in mid-August 2024. The current owner's family have until then to fully clear out the Villa so that Bryce Carters team can start the refurbishment process. This can take up to 3 months and dependent on the amount of work that is required.

QUICK TIPS

HOME PHONES

Recently there are a lot of people are having trouble with their phones.

Most phones can be fixed by turning them off, waiting a minute or two then turning back on, correcting a lot of these phones issues.

MODEMS

Both Bestcomm and other providers have handsets and a modem box. You can unplug the modem box to turn it off, wait a minute or two then plug it back in.



MODEM NOTE: Wait for all the lights to come back on at the front of the device, especially the phone light.

HANDSETS

With your handset hold down the phone icon (sometimes in red) until the handset turns off, wait a minute or two, then hold it down again and the handset should turn back on.

Some handsets have a on and off button on the side. If your phone does have a side button this is the way you should turn it off and on.
