Update on new street line marking in Village

Hanover Line-marking Services were called back on 2 further occasions to redo some street lines/arrows where the line marking paint had not gripped properly and the paint had come off. After further consideration by members of the Works Committee some past / new yellow lines will now be removed to ensure maximum parking spaces for residents and visitors.




A day with Charlie — our resident's cat
