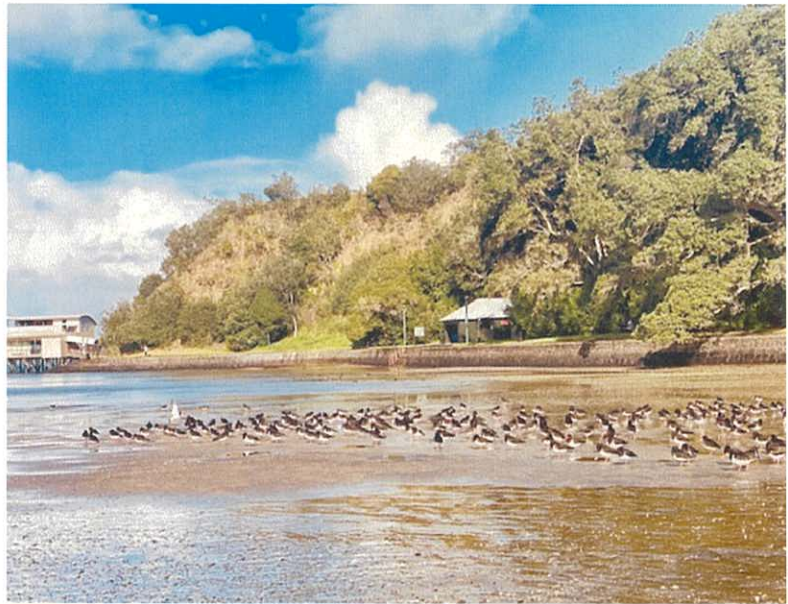
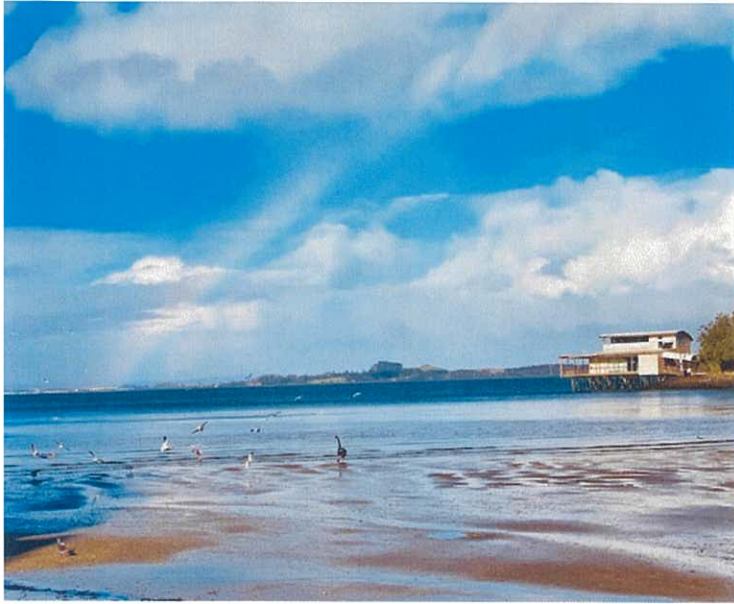

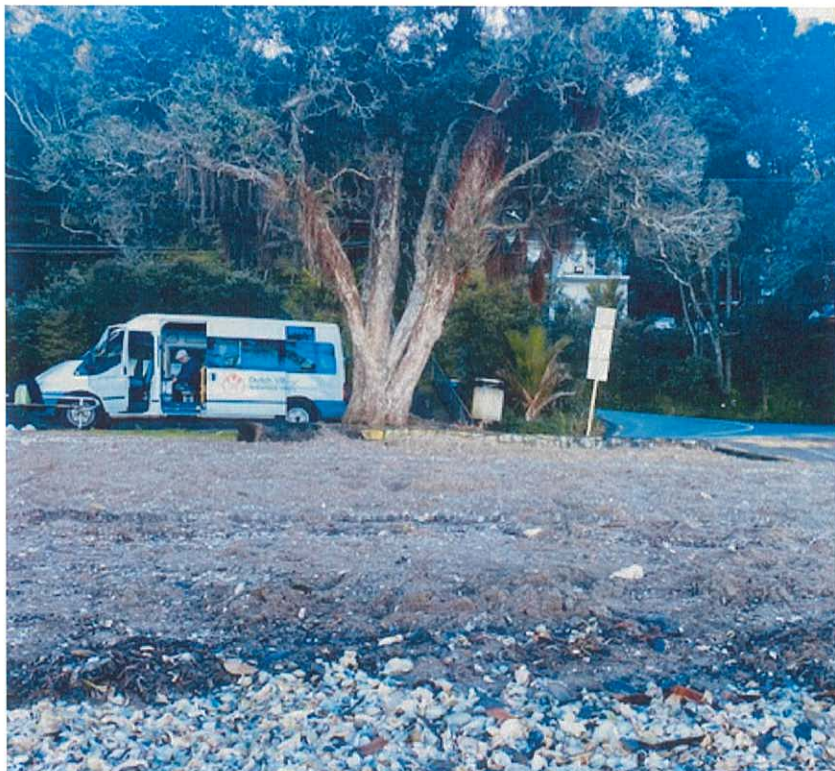


# News from the Ons Dorp Care Centre
