As mentioned in the August Grapevine Laser Plumbing currently working on 7 Villa Roofs (different levels of work required) in the Village. 2 Roofs have now been completed. Villa Sales Update

The full refurbishment of Villa 63 (which had a difficult layout) is currently underway by Bryce Carters team and is expected to be completed in approx. October/November 2025, before it can be sold. Villa 20 has a buyer who is in the process of selling their house.

Work on Village Drains/Sewage Lines

As previously reported we are now waiting for a detailed quote from Drain King Ltd for any work that needs to be done, as result of the CCTV camera work on the Village drains/sewage lines. This quote will go the September meeting of the Works Committee for a recommendation the Trust Board for approval. The Village is being proactive under its 10 Year Maintenance Plan to get this work done now before any such problems with the drains/sewage lines may deteriorate further.

Walking Group



Residents were very helpful folding napkins, dressing the tables with flower arrangements for the Happy Hour which was enjoyed by all.


















News from the Ons Dorp Care Centre Van Trips
