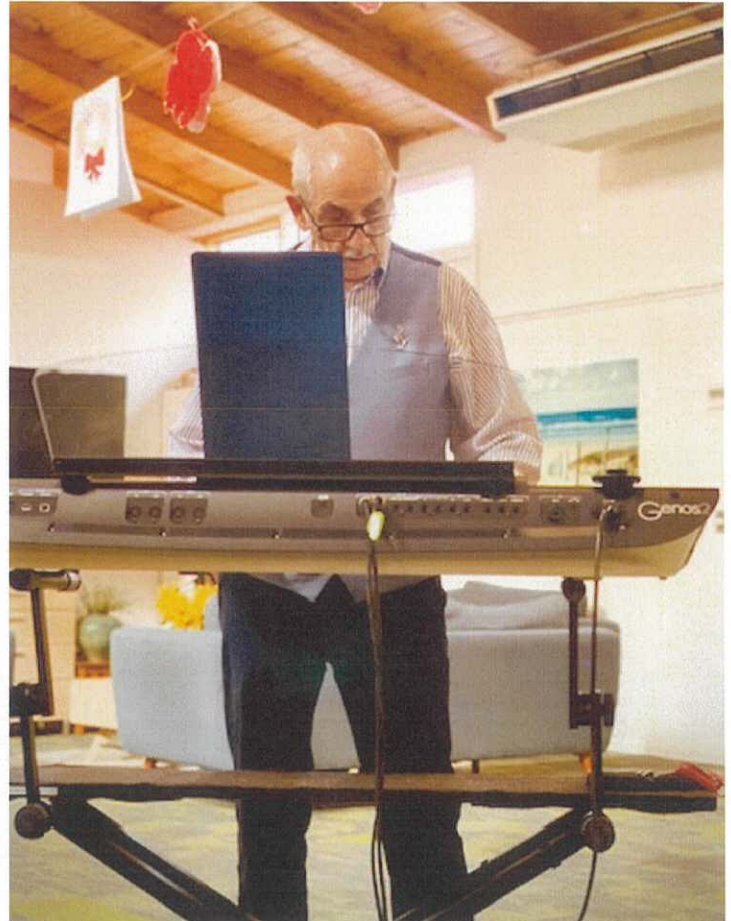

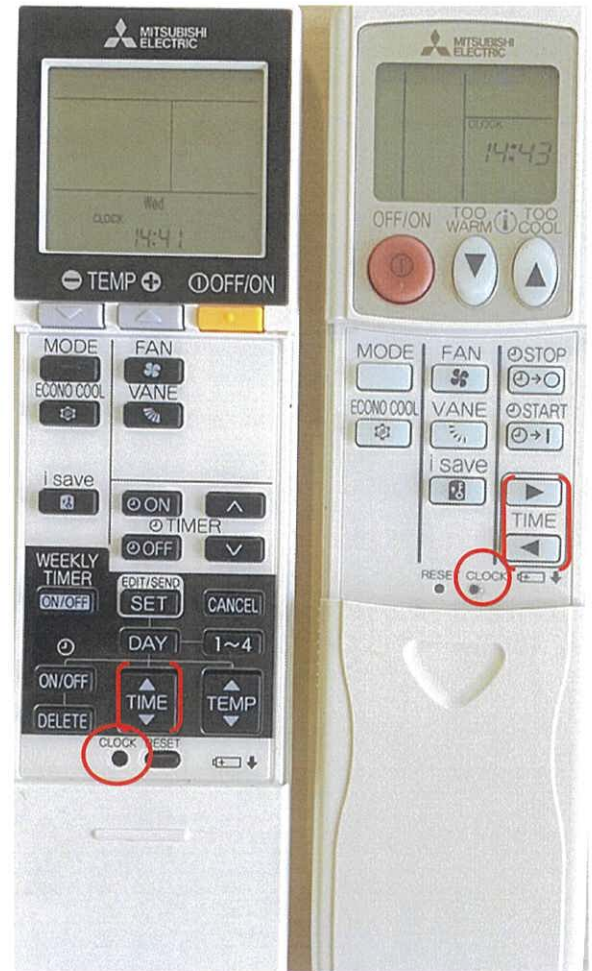
please have a table or chair available near your front door or sliding door for your meals to be delivered to.
