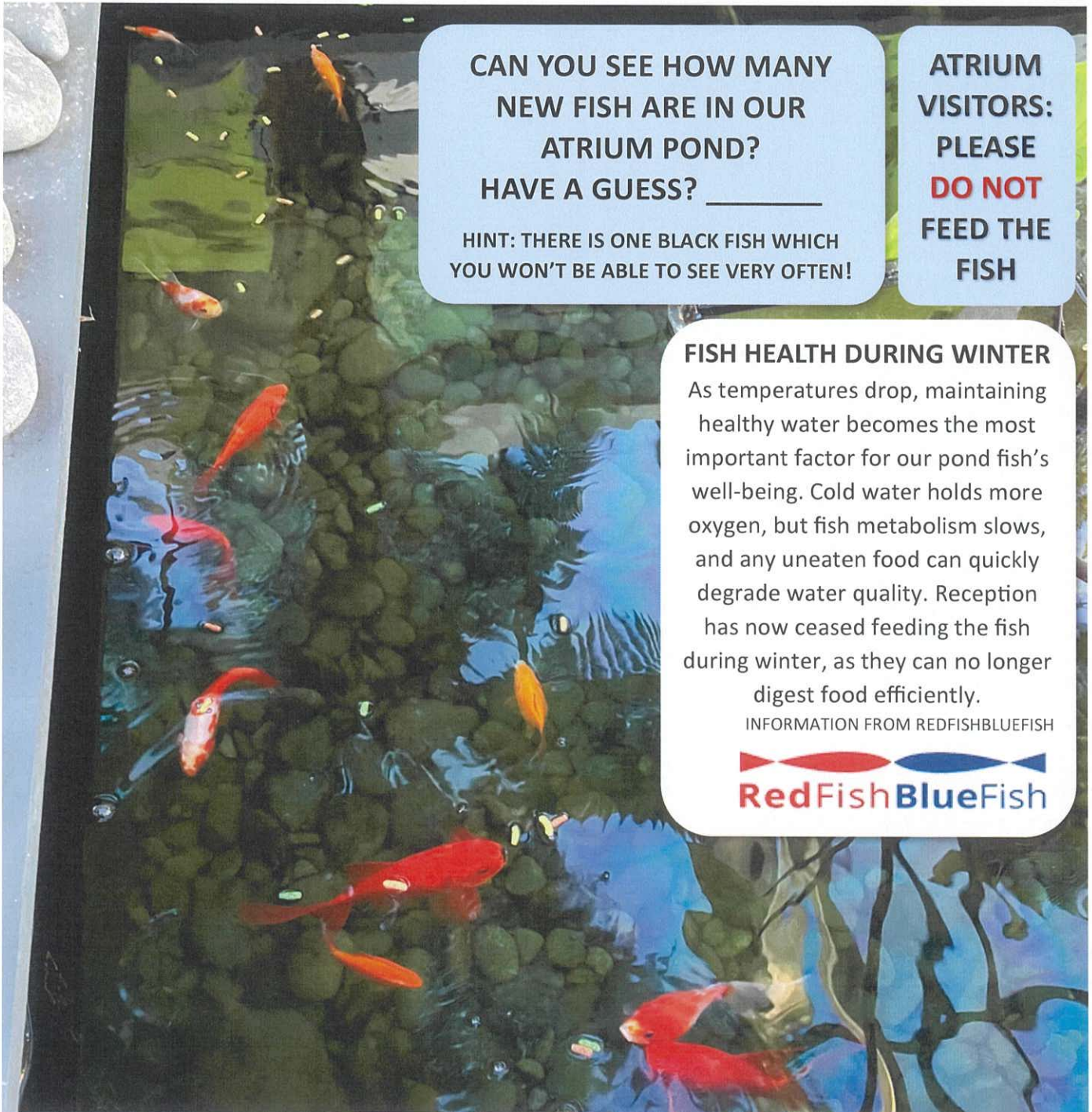

FISH HEALTH DURING WINTER

As temperatures drop, maintaining healthy water becomes the most important factor for our pond fish's well-being. Cold water holds more oxygen, but fish metabolism slows, and any uneaten food can quickly degrade water quality. Reception has now ceased feeding the fish during winter, as they can no longer digest food efficiently.
