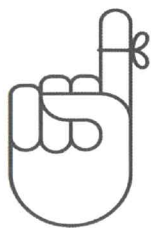

Subject: Barrier Arm

How the barrier arm works

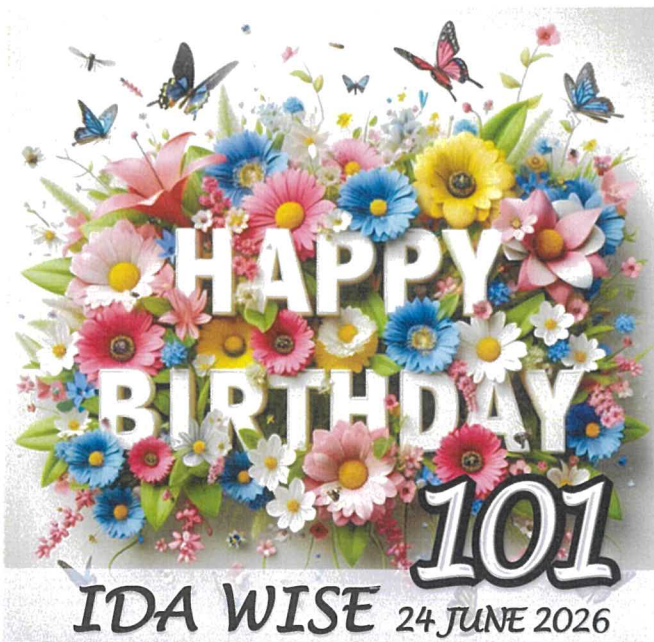
- There will be a sensor on either side of the gate on the road. So for the gate to operate, all you need to do is drive up to the barrier arm and wait for it to lift automatically.
- The barrier arm will be positioned away from the road to prevent a vehicle from blocking the road while waiting for the barrier arm to open.
- The barrier arm **will be up in the day & down over night** between pre-determined times.
- The barrier arm will have a **LED light** across it: **Red when DOWN**, and **Green when UP**.
- **Please be patient as you can only proceed when the barrier arm is GREEN.**
- In case of a power failure the barrier arm will have a backup battery.
- Beams are installed to prevent the barrier arm from closing if there is an obstruction.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be some disruption while the barrier arm is being installed as a concrete slab will need to be poured.

Access will be limited to one half of the road while the other side is being poured. Signs will be in place making sure give way rules are adhered to for vehicles coming in and out of the Village.

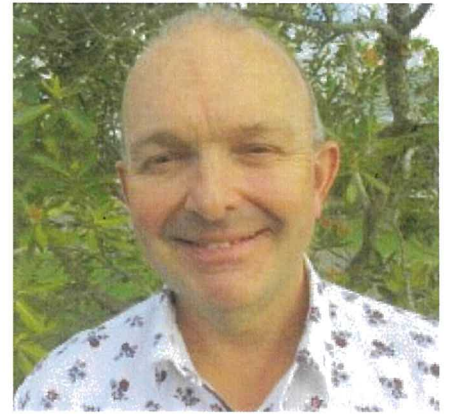

Care Centre Atrium Coffee Machine

- ♥ **Please keep the area tidy**

If you do need to tip your drink out there is a drain by the double doors of the Care Centre Hospital Lounge — tip all drinks into this.

NEED THE HEATERS ON?

Ask the Care Centre staff. There is a button just inside the Hospital lounge double doors — near the light switch.

Press the button once and the heaters will stay on for an hour

When you are posting a job on ACCESSMAPS and you can't find your specific job title, you can always select the "OTHER" option to proceed. Easy, just make sure you put specifics about your job such as: "My oven is not turning on" or "my bathroom sink is blocked". It is also easier to use OTHER than spending time scrolling through.

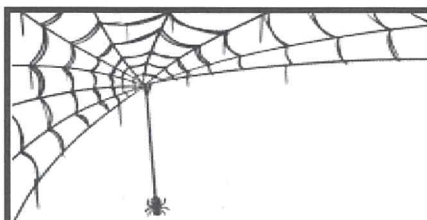
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COBWEBS
