In the week before, work commences on the Barrier Arm, a Special Notice will go out to residents.

Collins-Mattson Plumbing are also working in the side gardens of Villas 68 and 74 where there are some subsoil drainage issues that need to be fixed.

Villa sales/refurbishments

Villa 14 settled on 7 July, while Villas 63 (proposed settlement September 9) and 40 (proposed settlement October 1) have conditionally sold. Villa 72 is now available for sale while Villas 32 and 58 are in the process of full or part refurbishment.

Upgrading of the Village Van Lift

West Auckland Engineering Ltd have repaired and upgraded the lift but are still waiting for essential lift operational sensors which they expect by the 1st week in August. Subject to the sensors arriving the lift will then be refitted in the van which should be done by the mid-August or earlier. Regretfully with no van lift, for some residents in the Care Centre with mobility issues this has meant we could not take them out on Van outings, but the lift had to be repaired including the removal of rust on it.

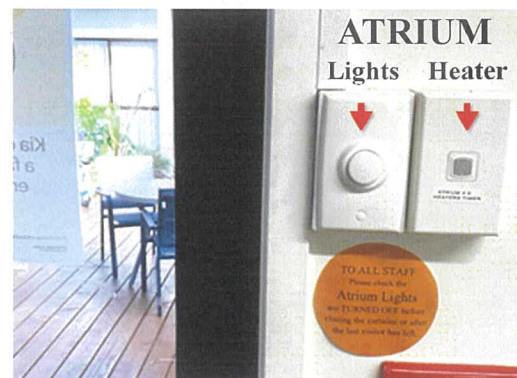
DO NOT tip drinks in the overflow tray

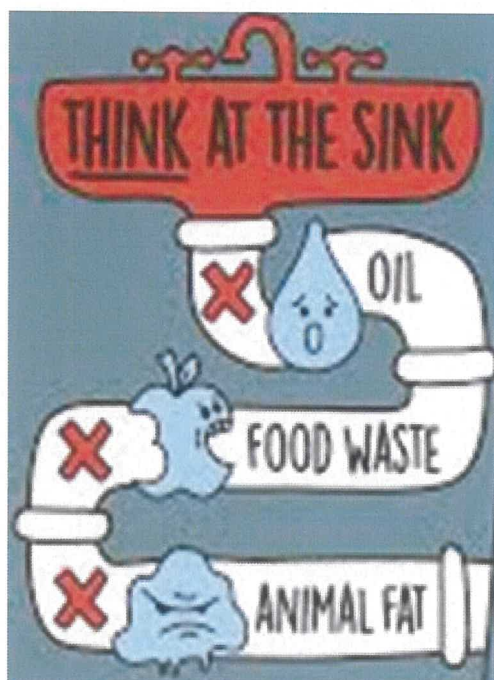

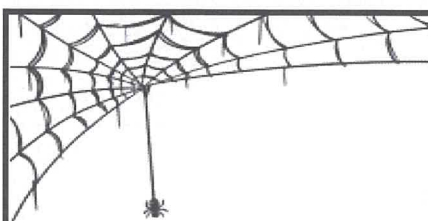
